Hengaw statistical report on the killing of at least 134 Kurdish citizens during the Jina revolution

According to the statistics collected by the Hengaw research team, 134 Kurdish citizens have been killed by government forces in various cities since the beginning of the Jina revolution. Also, at least 21 members of the Kurdish parties and an ordinary citizen from the Kurdistan Region have died during the IRGC drone and missile attacks, which were carried out under the pretext of responding to Kurdish parties organizing and forming protests in Kurdistan.

Separation based on the cause of death:

Direct fire of government forces; 114 cases equal to 85% of the total cases.

Killed due to torture; 9 cases equal 6.5% of the total cases.

Killed by batons; 6 cases equal 4.5% of the total cases.

killed by stab wounds; 1 case equals 8% of the total cases.

Killed by suffocation with tear gas; 1 case equals 8% of the total cases.

Run over by car; 1 case equals 8% of the total cases.

Execution; 1 case equals 8% of the total cases.

unknown; 1 case equals 8% of the total cases.

Verification of the identity of another number of those killed in recent days

In the recent report of Hengaw, the names of six more citizens who were killed by the government forces during the popular uprising and resistance, after the completion of the investigation, have been added to the list of the victims of the Jina Revolution.

Alireza Kakamohammadi from Harsin who was killed in Tehran, Alireza Hosseini from Kermanshah who was killed in Tehran, Mohammad Amin Hashmatian from Sanqar and Keliai who was killed in Karaj, Seyed Mohammad Hosseini from Saqqez, Hemn Hamzeh from Sardasht, and Matin Naseri are six people who were not included in the previous reports of Hengaw in the list of the dead, and after completing the information and investigation, these names were added to the list.

Women and children; 6 women and 13 children and teenagers among the killed

During the Jina Revolution, at least 5 women and girls died, identified as Minu Majidi from Qasr-e Shirin, Negin AbdolMaleki from Qorve, Kobra Sheikh Saqqa from Mahabad, Sarina Saedi from Sanandaj, Fereshte Ahmadi from Sardasht, and Nasrin Qaderi from Marivan. Three people were killed by the direct fire of the repressive government forces and three died due to multiple baton hits on their heads.

Also, at least 13 children and teenagers identified as Zakaria Khyal, 16, Amin Marefat, 16, Abdollah Mohammadpour, 16, Amir Fuladi, 15, Amir Hossein Basati, 15, Ali Mozafari Salanquch, 17, Nima Shafiqdoost, 16, Armin Seyedi, 18, Sarina Saedi, 16,

Komar Daroftadeh, 16, Danial Paybandi, 17, Bahaddin Veisi, 16, and Karvan Qader Shokri, 16, were killed during the recent revolution, 12 of them were killed by direct fire from the repressive government forces. One person was killed by a baton on the head.

It should be noted that in previous reports, Hengaw had announced that Momen Zand Karimi from Sanandaj was 18 and Reza Kazemi from Muchesh was 16. After completing the investigation, we announce that Mr. Zand Karimi was 19 and Mr. Kazemi was 22, and we apologize to all our audience.

Torture; At least 9 Kurdish citizens have been killed under torture

According to the investigation, at least 9 Kurdish citizens were killed under the torture of agents after being abducted by the government institutions of the Islamic Republic of Iran.

Ismail Dizwar from Saqqez, Mohammad Abdollahi from Ilam, Ramin Fathi from Sanandaj, Saman Qaderpour from Oshnavyeh, Omid Hosseini from Sanandaj, Hemn Aman from Bukan, Shadman Ahmadi from Dehgolan, Shahriar Adeli from Sardasht, and Mohammad Haji Rasulpour from Bukan are the people who were killed under the torture of government institutions after being arrested. They were killed.

The status of those who have been arrested or forcibly abducted:

According to the legal axioms, in terms of arrest, the accused is arrested when the accused complies with all the legal standards, including the submission of a court document, notification to the family, access to medical services, access to legal assistance and lawyer, and detention in the shortest possible time, explain the charges, and transferring to one of the official prisons in the list of the country's prisons organization.

What happened during the Jina revolution, according to Article 2 of the Convention for the Protection of All Persons from Enforced Disappearance, is a dangerous criminal act that is criminalized in international criminal law. Although the Iranian government has not joined this convention, the definition and examples of this criminal act have mostly taken on a customary aspect and governments are required to comply with it.

It is worth mentioning that even according to the minimum laws of the Islamic Republic, the defendant has these rights. But what we see in practice is the violation of all international legal standards by government forces in this field.

Following the passing of more than 5 months of protests, more than 7500 Kurdish citizens have been arrested and abducted by security agencies, and currently, the Hengaw research team can verify the identity of 2167 of them. Out of these 2167 people, 220 are women and 191 are children and teenagers.

It needs to be clarified, based on the investigations, Hengaw was informed that the detainees are subjected to physical and mental torture systematically.

Kurdistan province (Sanandaj) ranks first with 776 arrests out of a total of 2167 citizens whose identities have been verified. Also, the provinces of West Azerbaijan (Urmia) with 660 cases, Kermanshah with 360 cases, and Ilam with 290 cases are placed next. In the central cities of Iran, at least 81 Kurdish citizens have been abducted by government institutions.

Based on the statistics of Hengaw, the highest number of abducted citizens is recorded in the cities of Sanandaj with 334 cases, Piranshahr with 143 cases, Oshnavyeh with 126 cases, Mahabad with 126 cases, and Abdanan with 108 cases.

Judicial status of detainees

Based on the statistics registered in the Hengaw Statistics Center, out of the total number of people who were arrested during the Jina Revolution in Kurdistan, at least 111 have been sentenced to imprisonment and whipping, and one person has been sentenced to death by the judicial system of the Islamic Republic of Iran.

According to this report, 111 of these people have been sentenced to a total of 343 years and 3 months in prison, and Mohammad Mehdi Karami, who was sentenced to death, was executed in one of Karaj's prisons.

Also, 20 of these people have been sentenced to a total of 1076 lashes by the judicial system of the Islamic Republic, in addition to imprisonment.

In addition to these cases, at least 9 people were arrested in Kurdistan, called Parham Parvari from Saqqaz, Pouria Javaheri from Kamiyaran, Farhad Tahazadeh, Farzad Tahazadeh, Faryad Hamzeshur, Shahram Marufmolla, Reza Eslamdoost, Karvan Shahiparvaneh, and Farzad Mahmoudpour, all from Oshnavyeh, were accused to "Moharebeh and corruption on Earth", and this charge in Iran's judicial system can lead to death for the mentioned people.

Missile attacks on Kurdish parties and the death of at least 21 members of the parties

During the Jina revolution, in addition to the large massacres that the Islamic Republic started in the cities of Kurdistan, at least three times it attacked the camps and headquarters of the Kurdish parties "Democrat, Komala, and PAK" in the territory of the Kurdistan region with missile and drone. As a result of the attacks, at least 21 Peshmerga and members of these parties died, including two women, a one-day-old child, and an ordinary citizen from Koye, Erbil Province.

Iran's military authorities have repeatedly announced that these retaliatory attacks were in response to the organizing and calls of the parties for general strikes in Kurdistan, and in addition to the death of 20 members of the parties, tens of others were injured.

Wednesday, September 28, 2022

The Revolutionary Guards first bombarded the border areas of the Kurdistan region in Saidakan, Haji Omran, and Helgurd and used drones, and hours later, they simultaneously destroyed the headquarters of the Komala of the Toilers of Kurdistan, Komala Party of Iranian Kurdistan, Kurdistan Freedom Party (PAK), and the Kurdistan Democratic Party of Iran. The cities of Sulaymani, Erbil, and Koye were the targets of their missile and drone attacks.

In the attacks, 9 members of the Democratic Party, called Osman Faizah, Rihaneh Kanaani (pregnant woman), Vaniyar Rahmani (one-day-old child), Hajar Zargeh, Mohammad Khalili, Milad Pirsaheb, Shirko Bartani, Omar Mahmoodzadeh, and Ayoub Honarvar died. Also, 8 PAK members called Ehsan Faraji, Omid Nikdel, Yunes Ghiathi, Arvin Sohrabi, Yadullah Nouri, Saeed Omidi, Edris Amjadi, and Kamran Rostami died as a result of IRGC missile and drone attacks.

Monday, November 14, 2022

Simultaneously with the shelling of the positions of the Kurdish parties in the border heights, the Revolutionary Guards targeted the headquarters of the Kurdistan Democratic Party of Iran, the Kurdistan Komla Party of Iran, and the Komala of the Toilers of Kurdistan with their missiles and drone attacks.

In these attacks, at least three members of the Kurdistan Democratic Party of Iran, Called Rebwar Abdi, Aso Tawana, and Mohammad Badrout, as well as a civil citizen from Koye, Kurdistan Region, died.

Monday, November 21, 2022

IRGC missile and drone attacks on the bases and camps of the Komala of the Toilers of Kurdistan and the Kurdistan Democratic Party of Iran in the cities of Sulaymani, Koye, and Bahrka (Jezhnikan camp). As a result of the attacks, a member of the Democratic Party called Behzad Eskat was killed.

Tuesday, November 22, 2022

IRGC drone attacks on the Kurdistan Freedom Party (PAK) headquarters in Pirde, located between Erbil and Kirkuk.

A brief description of the martyrs of the Jinnah revolution according to the date of death

Monday, September 19, 2022

1- Mohsen Mohammadi; He was severely injured during the popular resistance of Divandareh, by direct fire from government forces and died after being transferred to Sanandaj medical centers.

2- Reza Lotfi; A 19-year-old youth from Dehgolan was killed by direct fire from government forces during the popular resistance in this city.

3- Fereidun Mahmoudi; A 32-year-old youth from Saqqez was killed by direct fire from government forces. The citizen was directly shot with a shotgun and a Kalashnikov. He was married and had one child.

Tuesday, September 20, 2022

4- Zakaria Khial; A 16-year-old teenager from Piranshahr was shot in the head by a government repressive force during the popular resistance of this city and died.

5- Farjad Darvishi; A 23-year-old young man from Balu village, Urmia, was hit by bullets from counter-insurgency forces in the stomach, heart, and lungs during popular resistance in Waliasr village of this city and died while being transported to the medical centers. He was single.

6- Minu Majidi; She was 62, from Qasr-e Shirin, and a resident of Kermanshah. The Kurdish citizen was one of the followers of the Yarsan religion, who was shot by

government forces on Vahdat Blvd of Kermanshah and died. According to the medical examiner's report, 167 shotgun bullets hit her body. She had three children.

7- Reza Shahparnia; A 22-year-old youth from Kermanshah was hit by more than 100 shotgun bullets in his head, eyes, face, and chest by the forces of the special unit and died. He was single and had spent his mandatory military service last year.

Wednesday, September 21, 2022

8- Foad Ghadimi; He was 39 and had two children; he was seriously injured in the abdomen and wrist by a Kalashnikov during the popular resistance of Divandareh and died after three days in Kowsar hospital in Sanandaj due to the severity of his injuries.

9- Amin Marafet; A 16-year-old teenager from Oshnavyeh was shot in the chest and heart with a Kalashnikov by repressive forces near the intersection of "Syed Abad" and died.

10- Danesh Rahnama; A 25-year-old young man from Balu village, Urmia, was killed by direct fire from Basij forces after the funeral ceremony of Farjad Darvishi in this village.

11- Sadraddin Litani; A 27-year-old man from Oshnavyeh (Shno) was shot in the head and chest by the IRGC forces during the popular resistance of this city near the "Seyed Abad" intersection and died. He was single.

12- Milan Haghighi, a 21-year-old young man who was born in Gothenburg, Sweden, was hit by direct fire from the Revolutionary Guards forces with three Kalashnikov bullets in the shoulder and leg during the popular resistance of Oshnavyeh near the "Seyed Abad" intersection and died.

13- Abdollah Mohammadpour; A 16-year-old teenager from Balu village, Urmia, was killed by Basij forces after the funeral ceremony of Farjad Darvishi while returning home in this village.

14- Saeid Mohammadi; A 21-year-old young man from Islamabad-Gharb (Shabad) was killed by direct fire from the Revolutionary Guards during the popular resistance of this city. He was single.

15- Amir Fuladi; A 16-year-old teenager from Islamabad-Gharb (Shabad) was killed by direct fire from the Revolutionary Guards forces during the popular resistance of this city.

16- Iman Mohammadi; A 22-year-old young man from Islamabad-Gharb (Shabad) was killed by direct fire from the Revolutionary Guards during the popular resistance of this city. He was single.

17- Mohsen Gheisari; A 32-year-old man from Ilam was killed by direct fire from special forces at a close range during the popular resistance of this city. He was single and was shot in the head and chest.

18- Alireza Fathi; A 22-year-old man from Sanghar and Kilyaei was shot in the stomach by government forces during the popular resistance of Qazvin city to the murder of Jina Amini in Alvand industrial town and was killed.

19- Amir Hossein Basati; A 15-year-old teenager from Kermanshah was killed by direct fire from special forces on Modares Street in this city. He was hit by more than 70 shotgun bullets from the back. After 8 days, his family got his body from Taleghani hospital and his funeral ceremony was held in Darkhor village, Hassan Abad.

20- Ali Mozaffari Salanquch; A 17-year-old boy from Quchan and a member of the Saipai youth volleyball team in Tehran was shot in the stomach by the repressive government forces during the popular resistance of this city and was killed. His body was handed over to his family after 4 days in return for receiving 50 million Tomans.

21- Rozbeh Khademian; A 32-year-old man from the city of Sanghar and Kilyaei was killed by the Revolutionary Guards during the popular resistance in the Fardis neighborhood in Karaj. This young man was hit by four bullets from a close distance in the back and shoulder.

22- Mohammad Zarei; A 22-year-old young man from Sanghar and Kilyaei was seriously injured by direct fire from the government forces during the popular resistance in the Bagharabad neighborhood, Qarchak city, Varamin, and died while being taken to medical centers.

23- Mehdi Babrnezhad, a 23-year-old young man from Quchan, Khorasan-Razavi province, was seriously injured by direct fire from the government forces during the popular resistance of this city. He died after being transferred to the hospital due to the delay in being transferred to the operating room.

24- Erfan Khazaei; A 30-year-old man from Kangavar city, during the popular uprising of Shahriar, Karaj, was directly shot in the head by government repressive forces and died.

Monday, September 26, 2022

25- Abdul Salam Qader Galwan, a young man from Oshnavyeh was seriously injured by direct fire from the government forces during the popular resistance on Wednesday, September 21, near the Seyed Abad intersection of this city, after being hospitalized for 6 days in the Khomeini Hospital in Urmia due to severity of injuries.

Wednesday, September 28, 2022

26- Samad Barginia; A 52-year-old citizen from Piranshahr, who was seriously injured during the popular resistance of this city on Tuesday evening, September 20, died in the Khomeini Hospital of Urmia due to the severity of his injuries. He was hit by 52 shotgun bullets in his head and eyes, and the medical examiner's report states that he died as a result of an object hitting his head. It is worth mentioning that he was severely beaten by government forces after being wounded.

Saturday, October 1, 2022

27- Mokhtar Ahmadi; A 19-year-old youth from Marivan was killed by direct fire from government forces during the popular resistance of this city, and his body was buried in the presence of fewer than 20 members of his family at 2 am under the pressure of security institutions. He made a living for himself and his family by selling handmade dolls on the streets.

Tuesday, October 4, 2022

28- Nima Shafiqdoost; A 17-year-old boy from Salmas, who was seriously injured in the leg during the popular resistance of Urmia on the evening of September 21, died after 12 days due to the severity of his injuries. After being injured, the teenager was not taken to the medical center due to the fear of being arrested, and on October 12, a few hours after being taken to the hospital, he died due to an infection at the wound.

It should be mentioned that after the news of the death of this teenager was published, Colonel Hassan Sheikhi, the Police Commander of Urmia, said that he died due to a dog bite. Nima's mother later denied Hassan Sheikhi's words by publishing a video.

Saturday, October 8, 2022

29- Dariush Alizadeh; A 33-year-old man from Sanandaj was seriously injured in the waist and thigh by direct fire from the government forces near the Baharestan neighborhood of this city. He died after being transferred to Be'sat Hospital due to severe injuries and bleeding. According to informed sources, government forces beat him while he was seriously injured.

30- Peiman Menbari; A 25-year-old citizen from the village of Nayir and a resident of Sanandaj was shot from behind by the government forces near the Mardokh bridge and killed. He was been shot in the back in such a way that the bullet passed his chest. In the death certificate of Peiman Menbari, the cause of his death is mentioned as the impact of hard or sharp objects.

31- Mohammad Amini; A young man from the "Taqtaqan" neighborhood of Sanandaj was killed by the direct fire of the government forces during the popular resistance of this city.

32- Yahya Rahimi; A 31-year-old worker from Sanandaj was directly shot in the head by plainclothesmen while he was driving on 6 Bahman street in this city, and he died. In the death certificate of Yahya Rahimi, the cause of his death is stated as a fracture and crushing of the skull bone and hit by a high-speed projectile.

Sunday, October 9, 2022

33- Ismail Dizwar; A 33-year-old young man from Saqqez was abducted by IRGC forces and died under torture after a few hours. It should be mentioned that during the funeral the Dizwar family was forced to announce the cause of their child's death as a car accident.

Monday, October 10, 2022

34- Arian Moridi; A 22-year-old young man from Salas-Babajani city was seriously injured by direct fire from the government forces on Sunday evening, October 9, during the popular resistance of this city, and died after being transferred to Kermanshah medical centers due to the severity of his injuries. The young man was directly shot by government forces in his chest and neck.

Wednesday, October 12, 2022

35- Armin Sayadi; An 18-year-old boy from Kermanshah was killed by direct fire from the repressive forces of the Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps during the popular resistance of this city and in the Daredrezh town. This young man was shot in the chest and side by government forces.

36- Sina Naderi; A 22-year-old man from Kermanshah was killed by direct fire from the repressive forces of the Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps during the popular resistance of this city and in the Daredrezh town. This young man was shot in the chest and arm by government forces.

37- Aziz Moradi; A citizen from Sanandaj was seriously injured in the thigh and stomach by direct fire from the government forces in the Nayser neighborhood on Wednesday, October 12 at 10:00 pm. He died after being transferred to the medical center due to the severity of his injuries.

38- Kamal Feghhi; A 46-year-old citizen from Bukan was seriously injured by direct fire from government forces during the popular resistance of this city while he was on the roof of his house located in the "Hesar" neighborhood, and died after being transferred to "Qolipur" hospital of this city. Kamal Feghhi was shot in the head and the cause of death by the forensic pathologist was stated as "blunt force trauma".

39- Mohammad Abdollahi; A 36-year-old man from Ilam was arrested by government forces during the popular resistance of Ilam in front of the city's governor's building and died under torture after a few hours. The security institutions handed over the body to his family after obtaining an undertaking from Mohammad's father that his death was natural.

40- Negin Abdolmaleki; A 21-year-old student of Hamedan University of Technology died after being hit with a baton by government forces during the popular resistance in Hamedan after returning to her dormitory. Government media attributed her death to alcohol consumption and forced her father to deny the news of his daughter's death by government forces in front of the camera.

41- Seyed Mohammad Hosseini; A young man from Saqqez was protesting against the destruction of citizens' cars by the government forces during the popular resistance in Mehr houses in Kuhdasht when the Anti-riot car ran over his body twice and he died. In the obituary, the government institutions had forced his family to state the cause of his death as a car accident.

Wednesday, October 19, 2022

42- Alireza Hosseini; A citizen from Kermanshah and a resident of Tehran, was killed by direct fire from government forces after the raid of the government forces to arrest him in his house. Suspecting his presence during popular protests, the government forces invaded his and his friends' house.

Thursday, October 20, 2022

43- Ramin Karami; A 31-year-old young man from Sarpol Zahab city, who was seriously injured by direct fire from the government forces during the popular resistance in Kermanshah on Wednesday evening, October 12, died as a result of his injuries. The exact date of his death is not known, but on October 20, his family was informed of his death.

Friday; October 21, 2022

44- Ramin Fatehi; A 47-year-old citizen from Sanandaj died only 9 days after being detained by the forces of the Sanandaj Intelligence Department under the torture of this security institution. He was previously arrested along with his brother and sister, and during the detention period, he was forced to confess under the pressure and torture of the security agencies.

Wednesday, October 26, 2022

45- Mohammad Shariati; A 21-year-old man from Mochesh and a resident of Sanandaj was killed by direct fire from the government forces in the Kamarbandi 25 area of Sanandaj. He was the only child of a family.

46- Simko (Esmail) Mowludi; A 35-year-old man from Mahabad was shot by IRGC forces from the side with a sniper rifle during the popular resistance of this city at 21:00 in the "Posht Tape" neighborhood and died after being taken to a medical center. He was married and had one child.

47- Afshin Asham, a 28-year-old youth from Sorkhak Sanjabi village and a resident of the Paliabad neighborhood of Qasr-e Shirin city was killed by direct fire from IRGC forces in the chest and stomach during the widespread resistance of this city. Nabi Akram Kermanshah Corps had requested 250 million Tomans to deliver his body to his family.

48- Keyvan Darvishi; A 42-year-old citizen from Sanandaj was shot by government forces in the Kamarbandi neighborhood of Sanandaj and died due to the severity of his injuries. In the death certificate of this citizen, the reason for his death is cardiac arrest.

49- Mohammad Lotfollahi; A young man from Sanandaj was shot by the government forces during the popular resistance of this city in the Naysar neighborhood, and while he was seriously injured, he was arrested and severely beaten in the van of the government forces and died. In addition to the injuries caused by the direct firing of the government forces, the bruises on his body were clearly visible.

50- Ebrahim Mirzaei; A 42-year-old citizen from Dehgolan and a resident of Sanandaj suffered breathing problems after being thrown tear gas by the government forces at the Abbas Abad intersection in Sanandaj and died after returning home.

Thursday, October 27, 2022

51- Zaniar Abubakri; A 21-year-old youth from Mahabad was shot from behind by government forces with a Kalashnikov near Simorgh square. The bullet passed through his stomach and cut his black vein. The young man had a fiance.

52- Kobra Sheikh Saqqa, a 59-year-old citizen from Mahabad, was killed by direct fire from government forces on Malajami street. A bullet hit her neck.

53- Shaho Khezri; A 21-year-old man from Mahabad was killed by direct fire from government forces after the funeral ceremony of Semko Mowludi. He was shot by government forces with a Kalashnikov.

54- Fereidoun Faraji; A 28-year-old man from Saqqez was killed by direct fire from the IRGC forces during the popular resistance in Baneh city. He was working in a restaurant in Baneh and was shot by government forces from behind with a Kalashnikov.

55- Sarina Saedi; A 16-year-old teenager from Sanandaj, who suffered a brain hemorrhage after being hit with a baton by the government forces in the Nayser neighborhood of Sanandaj on Wednesday evening, October 26, died after being hospitalized for a day at Towhid Hospital in Sanandaj. Her body was buried at night and on the same night, the government institutions forced her father to confess to deny his daughter's death during popular resistance.

It should be noted that the governor of Sanandaj at that time stated that the reason for Sarina's death was drug use. Meanwhile, the death certificate of this teenager states that the cause of her death is unknown.

56- Motaleb Saeed Pirou; The young man from Baneh was shot by the IRGC forces from a distance of one meter with a Kalashnikov while he was in his car and died. He was from Choman village, Bane, and the bullet hit his shoulder and exited his chest.

57- Fereshte Ahmadi, 32, was from Sardasht. She was a resident of Mahabad and while on the roof of her house, she was shot in the chest by direct fire from government forces and died. Fereshte was married and had two children. It should be mentioned that the government media stated that the cause of her death was a shooting from inside their own house. A claim that was strongly denied by Fereshta's family members.

58- Hamid Goli; A 46-year-old citizen from Sanandaj was killed during the popular resistance in Tehran due to multiple baton hits by government forces on his head and face. In the death certificate of Mr. Goli, it is mentioned that he suffered a brain hemorrhage and a skull fracture due to being hit by a hard object.

Friday, October 28, 2022

59- Masoud Ahmadzadeh; A 27-year-old dentist from Mahabad, who was seriously injured by direct fire from government forces near his office during the popular resistance on Thursday, October 27, died due to the severity of his injuries.

60- Dastan Rasul Mohammad Agha; A young man from the Kurdistan Region, who had gone to Baneh for the funeral of his friend Motaleb Saeed Pirou, was shot in the head with a Kalashnikov near the border and died.

Saturday, October 29, 2022

61- Saman Qaderpour; This former prisoner was arrested by government forces during the popular resistance in Tehran and died under torture. The governmental institutions had stated the cause of his death as cardiac arrest, but Saman's uncle had seen his body and had reported that the signs of beating and bruises were visible on his body.

Sunday, October 30, 2022

62- Komar Daroftadeh; A 16-year-old teenager from Piranshahr, who was targeted by government forces with a shotgun during the popular resistance of this city and near Owraz square, died in Khomeini Hospital due to the severity of his injuries. It is worth mentioning that government forces shot at this teenager from a distance of 3 meters.

Wednesday, November 2, 2022

63 - Momen Zandkarimi; A 19-year-old young man from Sanandaj was shot by government repressive forces at the Golshan intersection of this city from a distance of two meters and died due to heavy bleeding while being transported to Towhid Hospital. It should be mentioned that after this teenager was injured, the government forces deliberately kicked him in the head many times.

Thursday, November 3, 2022

64- Mohammad Amin Heshmatian, a young man from Sanghar and Kilyaei, was killed by direct fire from government repressive forces during the popular resistance of Karaj. His body was buried in Senanle village (his hometown) and the government institutions had pressured his family to announce the cause of their son's death as suicide.

65- Alireza Kakamohammadi, a young man from Harsin and a resident of Karaj, was killed by direct fire from the repressive government forces during the popular resistance of this city. Hengaw sources reported that government forces beat him while he was seriously injured.

Saturday, November 5, 2022

66- Nasrin Qaderi; A 38-year-old citizen from Marivan and a resident of Tehran, was severely injured by government forces in her home due to publishing protest posts against the murder of Zhina Amini and Nika Shakrami, after being transferred to one of the hospitals in Tehran died due to the severity of her injuries. The government institutions forced her father to state the reason for his daughter's death in front of the camera, and later at her funeral, Nasrin's brother said that my father was forced to confess.

Wednesday, November 9, 2022

67- Alireza Karimi, a 20-year-old young man from Islamabad Gharb (Shabad) and a microbiology student at Arak Azad University, suffered a stroke and died due to multiple baton blows inflicted on his head by government forces.

68- Fayeq Mamqaderi, a 35-year-old citizen from Mahabad, who was shot 6 times in the head, stomach, and hand during the popular resistance on October 12 in this city

and near Esteghlal Square, was hospitalized in Khomeini Hospital of Urmia for about a month died due to severe injuries.

Thursday, November 10, 2022

69- Ardalan Ghasemi; A 44-year-old citizen from Gilan-e Gharb was seriously injured by direct fire from the government forces while writing slogans on Taqbostan Boulevard in Kermanshah and died after being transferred to Taleghani Hospital. He was hit by three bullets in his stomach and shoulder.

Friday, November 11, 2022

70- Saman Rahmani; A 28-year-old man from Tekab died while chanting slogans in Qale Hassan Khan (Quds town) with multiple batons blows inflicted on his head by government forces. He was arrested and beaten during detention.

71- Hemn Hamze; A 30-year-old man was killed by direct fire during the government forces' attack on Bewran village. He was married and had two children and was directly shot in the chest.

Tuesday, November 15, 2022

72 - Foad Mohammadi; A 38-year-old man from Mavian village, Kamiyaran, was seriously injured by direct fire from government forces during the popular resistance of this city and died after being transferred to Sina Hospital. He was shot with a Kalashnikov; he was married and had two children.

73 - Zaniar Allah Moradi; A 26-year-old man from Sanandaj was targeted by government forces from a close range with a shotgun in the Kani Kuzale neighborhood of this city and died of internal bleeding after being transferred to

Towhid Hospital. The body of this young man was hit by more than a hundred bullets. He had previously lost his hand due to an electric shock.

74- Isa Biglari; A 39-year-old citizen from the "Nasar" village, Sarvabad, and a resident of Sanandaj was seriously injured in front of the Kurdistan University building gate by direct fire from government forces and died after being transferred to Towhid Hospital. He was shot twice in the waist with a Kalashnikov. This citizen was married and had three children.

75- Saman Ghaderbeigi; A young man from Bukan was killed by direct fire from government forces in the Mirzaei neighborhood of Bukan and his body was taken to Mahabad and then to Urmia. It should be mentioned that the government institutions had pressured his family to announce the cause of their son's death as suicide.

Wednesday, November 16, 2022

76 - Danial Paybandi; A 17-year-old teenager from Saqqez was shot by the government forces from close range in the Karimabad neighborhood and died on the spot. This teenager was shot in the stomach so parts of his internal organs were left in that place.

77- Borhan Karami; A 30-year-old man from Cherosaneh village, Kamiyaran, was killed by direct fire from government forces on "Zarneh" street in this city. He was shot three times in the head and neck with a Kalashnikov. Borhan Karami was married and had one child.

78-Salar Mojaver; A 30-year-old boy from Bukan was shot by the government forces from close range during the popular resistance of the Mirabad (Amirabad) neighborhood and died. He was a graduate of architecture and was shot by the government forces in his head.

79- Asaad Rahimi; A 30-year-old man from Bukan was killed by direct fire from the Revolutionary Guards forces during the popular resistance of this city.

80- Mohammad Hassanzadeh, a 28-year-old man from Bukan, was killed by government forces in his chest and heart using a knife while trying to free a girl abducted by repressive forces in the Bagh Ghazi neighborhood.

81- Shaho Bahmani, a young man from Divandareh and a resident of Sanandaj, was killed by direct fire from government forces near the Qeshlaq bridge after the funeral ceremony of 4 of the victims of the popular resistance in Sanandaj, and his body was taken to Kowsar Hospital in this city.

82- Aram Habibi; A 27-year-old man from Sanandaj was killed by direct fire from the government forces after the funeral ceremony of 4 of the victims of the popular resistance in Sanandaj and near the Qeshlaq bridge, and his body was taken to Kowsar Hospital in this city.

83- Farhad Khosravi; A 35-year-old man from Kermanshah was killed by direct fire from the government forces during the popular resistance in Sanandaj, and his body was taken to Kowsar Hospital, and his body was handed over to his family after a week.

Thursday, November 17, 2022

84- Abdurrahman Bakhtiari, a 66-year-old citizen from Saqqez, was directly shot by the government forces in front of his house on Saadi street, while he was inside his car and died. He was hit by two bullets.

85- Hazhar Mamkhosravi; A 20-year-old boy from Bukan was seriously injured during the popular resistance of this city by direct fire from the Revolutionary Guards and died after being transferred to Qolipur Hospital.

86- Amjad Enayati; A 23-year-old boy from Bukan was killed by direct fire from the repressive government forces during the popular resistance of this city.

87- Hiva Janjan; A 32-year-old citizen from Bukan was killed by direct fire from government forces during the popular resistance in this city.

88- Omid Hasani, a 22-year-old young man from Paygolan village and a resident of Sanandaj, was arrested by the IRGC forces during the funeral ceremony of 4 of the victims of Sanandaj and died under torture after a few hours. His relatives have confirmed the presence of torture marks on his head and neck.

89- Mustafa Shabani; A citizen of Bukan was killed by direct fire from the repressive government forces on Sardar Aziz Khan Mokri street of this city. It is worth mentioning that to prevent his funeral, the government forces arrested his brother and sister, Kamil and Kowsar Shabani.

90- Azad Hosseinpour, a citizen of Mahabad, was shot by government forces during the popular resistance of this city and was killed. He was a dentist.

91- Ghafur Mowlodi; A 65-year-old citizen from Bukan was killed by direct fire from government forces during the popular resistance in this city. He was married and had three children.

92- Aso Qaderi; A 26-year-old young man from Rabat district of Sardasht, was shot by government forces while he was in his car in Baneh and died. He died as a result of being shot by three bullets (2 in the head and 1 in the shoulder) and his body was buried at night under security conditions. Friday, November 18, 2022

93- Mohammad Ahmadi Gagash; A 43-year-old citizen from Mahabad was shot in the head by direct fire from the government forces while standing on the roof of his house during the popular resistance of this city and died.

94- Amir Farasatishad; A citizen from Piranshahr was killed by direct fire from the government forces in the Kamarbandi neighborhood of this city.

95- Milad Maarufi; A 23-year-old rider from Bukan, who was shot by government forces during the popular resistance on Thursday evening, November 17, died of his injuries at the Qolipur Hospital in Bukan.

96- Seyed Kamal Ahmedpour; A 34-year-old citizen from Mahabad was seriously injured by direct fire from the government forces on Manbaa street in this city, and while being transported to the Khomeini Hospital of this city, he died due to the severity of his injuries. He was married and had two children.

97- Mehran Rahmani; A citizen from Mahabad, who was targeted by government forces during the popular resistance on Thursday, November 17, in the Beri Shilan neighborhood, died in the Khomeini Hospital of Urmia due to the severity of his injuries.

98- Shahriar Mohammadi; A young man from Bukan was killed by direct fire from the government forces during the popular resistance in this city.

99- Saadi Shahrokhifar; A 35-year-old man from Bukan was killed by direct fire from the Revolutionary Guards forces at the "Emam Jumeh" intersection while he was on his way home, and later his body was abducted by the forces.

Saturday, November 19, 2022

100- Foad Sawari; A citizen of Divandareh was directly shot by the repressive forces of the government with a shotgun in the 16-meter street of this city, and died.

101- Habibollah Fathi; A 62-year-old citizen from Divandareh was shot by government repressive forces in the 16-meter street of this city and died. Due to the pressure of government institutions, his body was buried without issuing a death certificate.

102- Hossein Abdpanah; A 70-year-old citizen from Sanandaj was directly shot by government forces in Baharan town of this city in front of his own house and died.

Sunday, November 20, 2022

103. Erfan Kakayi; A 50-year-old citizen from Javanrood was killed by direct fire from government forces on his return to the Shahverdi neighborhood. He was the sports teacher at Javanrood High Schools and was targeted in the stomach.

104. Bahaddin Veisi; A 16-year-old teenager from Javanrood was killed by direct fire from repressive government forces during the city's popular resistance. The same night, Najmaddin Veisi, his older brother, was also wounded and abducted by government forces, and later forced to confess under pressure from government agencies.

105 . Suleiman Shokri; A 22-year-old young man from Bukan was targeted by a shotgun on November 17 in the head and neck on Aliabad street of the city by government repressive forces, and after three days died due to severe injuries in

Khomeini Hospital of Urmia. The security agencies had received 90 million tomans in exchange for handing over his body to his family.

106. Mohsen Niazi; A 25-year-old climber from Dehgolan was severely injured in the city during the city's popular resistance by the direct fire from government forces and was killed after being taken to Kowsar Hospital in Sanandaj.

107. Jalal Ghorbani; A 50-year-old citizen from Piranshahr was shot in the stomach by government repressive forces while transferring the body of Keivan Ghader Shokri, a 16-year-old teenager, to Shinabad mosque and died.

108- Taher Azizi; A 30-year-old citizen from Piranshahr was killed by direct fire from government forces during the popular resistance of this city. He was married and had two children.

109 Karvan Ghader Shokri; A 16-year-old teenager from Piranshahr, who was injured by direct fire from government repressive forces on Saturday evening, November 19, during the popular resistance of this city, died due to the severity of his injuries.

Monday, November 21, 2022

110. Jowhar Fathi; After the funeral of two of the victims of the popular resistance of Javanroud, he was killed by direct fire from the forces of the IRGC forces (Nabi Akram Corps of Kermanshah) in Behdari Street of Javanroud. On this day, the IRGC forces used G-3 weapons and machine guns.

111. Tahsin Miri; A Kolbar from Jarvanroud was killed by direct fire from forces (Nabi Akram corps of Kermanshah) on Behdari Street in Javanuroud after the funeral of two of the victims of the Javanroud popular resistance. He was directly targeted by the forces in his head. On this day, IRGC forces used G-3 weapons and machine guns.

112. Jamal Azimi; A citizen of Javanroud was killed by the forces of Nabi Akram forces of Kermanshah in Behdari street of Javanroud after the funeral of two of the victims of the popular resistance of Javanroud. He was directly shot by two bullets and died while he returned to help Tahsin Miri who was injured. On this day, IRGC forces used G-3 weapons and machine guns.

113 Esmail Golanbar; A citizen of Javanrood was killed by direct fire from the forces of Nabi Akram Kermanshah's forces in Behdari street of Javanrood after the funeral of two of the victims of the popular resistance of Javanrood. IRGC forces used G-3 weapons and machine guns on this day.

114 Masoud Teimuri; A young man from Javanroud was seriously injured by the direct fire of Kermanshah's Nabi Akram Corps forces on Behdari Street in this city and died after being transferred to medical centers. His father, Mahmoud Teimuri, was also injured and due to his bad physical condition, he was informed about his son's death after a month.

115- Korosh Pazhakh; A young man from Islamabad Gharb was killed by direct fire from government repressive forces during the popular resistance of Kermanshah in the Elahiye neighborhood of this city. He was a follower of the Yarsan religion.

Tuesday, November 22, 2022

116- Rebaz Salehivand; A 21-year-old young man from Mahabad, near Haji Mamian village of this city, while riding a motorcycle, was directly shot by the IRGC forces with a shotgun and died.

Wednesday, November 23, 2022

117- Hemn Aman; A 26-year-old young man from Bukan was wounded by direct fire from government forces on Friday, November 18, and then abducted, and died under torture by the Urmia's intelligence forces.

Thursday, November 24, 2022

118- Shamal Khadiripur; A 32-year-old man from Mahabad died of severe injuries in Khomeini Hospital of Urmia. On Friday, November 18, after the funeral of Azad Hosseinpour in Esteghlal Square of Mahabad, he was targeted directly by the IRGC forces in his chest and stomach

119-Jabar Farghizadeh; A 36-year-old man from Marivan, was hit by two bullets from the Revolutionary Guards forces while he was driving to his hometown, the "Asnabad" village, at 6:00 p.m. and died.

Sunday, November 27, 2022

120- Shoresh Niknam; A 36-year-old man from Mahabad died after being hospitalized for four days in "Seyed Shohada" hospital in Urmia due to the severity of his injuries. On Thursday, November 17, he was directly shot by IRGC forces in his stomach and chest in the Beri Shilan neighborhood.

121- Reza Kazemi; A 22-year-old man from Mochesh district, Kamiyaran, died after being hospitalized for 6 days in Kowsar hospital of Sanandaj due to severe injuries. On November 22, he was directly shot in the chest and stomach by the IRGC forces. Earlier, Hengaw had announced that he is 16, but after Hengaw's follow-up, it was found that he is 22.

Tuesday, November 29, 2022

122- Ebrahim Sharifi; A 29-year-old young man from Bukan died during the popular resistance of this city, after being hospitalized for 13 days in "Seyed Shohada" hospital in Urmia, due to the severity of his injuries. On November 16, he was the target of direct fire from the IRGC forces in the chest.

Wednesday, November 30, 2022

123- Avat Qaderpour; A 20-year-old man from Bukan died after being hospitalized for 12 days at Arefian Hospital in Urmia due to the severity of his injuries. On Friday, November 18, he was shot by IRGC forces while driving his car in Nachit village.

124- Farzin Maroufi; A 22-year-old man from Mahabad and a resident of Ekbatan town in Tehran, after the defeat of the Iranian football team against the United States in the Qatar World Cup, came to the streets to express his happiness, and he was killed by direct fire from the repressive government forces. Government institutions did not allow his body to be transferred to Mahabad.

125- Ehsan Ghasemi; A 32-year-old citizen from Kangavar and a resident of Karaj was killed by direct fire from repressive government forces in celebrating the defeat of the Iranian football team against the United States in the Qatar World Cup with people in the Sarasiyab neighborhood of Karaj. He was one of Iran's bodybuilding champions and had participated in international competitions.

Tuesday, December 6, 2022

126- Sepehr Azami, a 24-year-old young man, a follower of the Yarsan religion and a resident of Sahne, was injured by direct fire from government forces on the 40th day

of Hadis Najafi's death, died due to the severity of his injuries. He was shot in the left side of his chest and close to his heart.

Wednesday, December 7, 2022

127- Human Abdollahi, a 21-year-old youth from Sanandaj, was wounded by direct fire from the government forces during the popular resistance in the Hassanabad neighborhood of Sanandaj and died after being transferred to Kowsar Hospital due to the severity of his injuries. He was shot in the chest.

128- Matin Naseri; A 19-year-old man from Sanandaj, who was serving his mandatory military service, was suspiciously killed for disobeying the order of his superiors to participate in the suppression of popular resistance.

Thursday, December 8, 2022

129- Shadman Ahmadi, a 33-year-old man from Dehgolan, a few hours after being abducted by government institutions, died in the police station of this city under the torture of repressive government forces. According to the video published by Hengaw, the marks of beating and bruises on his head, neck, and chest were clearly visible.

130- Shahriar Adeli, a 25-year-old young man from Sardasht, was arrested on November 30 while celebrating the defeat of the Iranian football team against the United States during the World Cup in Qatar with the people of Sardasht, and after a while and being severely tortured, he died due to the severity of injuries.

Monday, December 19, 2022

131- Mohammad Haji Rasulpour; 57 and a former political prisoner from Bukan, died after 5 days of coma caused by torture in security detention centers in "Qolipur" hospital of Bukan. Hengaw has been informed that the security agencies had refused to give him water for three weeks and that is why he went into a coma.

Saturday, December 31, 2022

132- Borhan Elyasi; A 22-year-old young man from Javanroud was injured in the shoulder by the direct fire of the repressive government forces during the 40th day of the commemoration ceremony of the victims of this city and died due to the severity of his injuries after being transferred to "Rasoul Akram" hospital.

Saturday, January 7, 2023

133- Mohammad Mehdi Karami; A 22-year-old young man from Karaj who was arrested on the 40th day of Hadis Najafi's death in Karaj, later he was sentenced to death by the judicial system of the Islamic Republic of Iran. His sentence was executed along with another citizen called Seyed Mohammad Hosseini in Karaj.

Saturday, February 18, 2023

134- Mokhtar Fathi; A 32-year-old man from Saqqez was killed by direct fire from police forces of police station 12 near his home while he was driving his car, on suspicion of writing slogans. He was married and his wife is pregnant.
